If you are OPPOSED to the proposition or question, complete the oval next to the word NO.</p> <p>WRITE-IN: To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, write his or her name in the blank space provided for such purposes and complete the oval next to the space provided.</p>	<p align="center">R-2 Cuba School District Proposition K.I.D.S</p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of the Crawford County R-II School District, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000) with an estimated no tax increase in the current debt service property tax levy for the purpose of providing funds to complete heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) upgrades; to repair, replace, or pave parking lots; to renovate existing and add additional restrooms; to improve or replace athletic field and parking lot lighting; to repair and reinforce exterior masonry walls; to replace the playground surface; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.5600 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>	<p align="center">R-1 Bourbon School District Question</p> <p>Shall Crawford County R-1 School District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$8,000,000, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school sites and facilities, including safety and security improvements, repairing and replacing roofs and HVAC systems, making renovations to District facilities, upgrading playground facilities at the Elementary School and Middle School, and site improvements to parking lots?</p> <p>If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9350 per \$100 dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>
