9:00 a.m.: Pastor Frank Brooks opened the meeting with prayer.

9:03 a.m.: County Official Reports:

Kim Gibbs mentioned that the County Clerk's office will be closed Wednesday after the election next week.

The opioid board made some recommendations for fund disbursements. The first recommendation was to RachelsAngels in the amount of \$4,000.00 to help create a billboard for

illegal drug awareness. Steve Black made the motion to approve RachelsAngels to receive said funds. Jared Boast Seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried.

The second recommendation was to Compass Health in the amount of \$46,613.02 to change the funds from going to transportation needs to help with start-up housing for those in need. Steve Black made a motion to approve said funds to be reallocated to start-up housing. Jared Boast seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried.

Jax Jensen had questions on transportation needs from Compass Health and the repurposed funds to be used on start-up housing. He also asked when the audit report would be available to the public.
