9:01 a.m.: Steve Black opened the meeting with prayer.

9:02 a.m.: Mark Pfeiffer made a motion to accept the agenda for the July 20th, 2026, meeting of the Crawford County Commission. Jared Boast seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried.

9:03 a.m.: Mark Pfeiffer made a motion to approve the Crawford County Commission meeting minutes for July 7th, 2026, meeting of the Crawford County Commission. Jared Boast seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried.

9:03 a.m.: County Official Reports:

Karen Sikes gave the Commission her pooled cash report.

Kim Gibbs mentioned that no-excuse, early voting starts tomorrow in the County Clerk's office. She also mentioned that the public test is Tuesday, July 21st at 2pm in the Commission office.

Steve Black said that he has a meeting with FEMA at 9 am Wednesday morning regarding flooding issues. He also mentioned that he had called the insurance adjuster but was still waiting to hear back. Steve also reached out to Servpro about giving us a bid on cleaning, etc... the building in Cuba.

Mark Pfeiffer gave an update on the flood damage in Davisville. He mentioned that the roads were still not in great condition, but there is access with high clearance vehicles. He said that they are working daily on the roads to try to get them in better condition.

Jared Boast mentioned that several people approached him at the fair last week and praised the efforts of the County with the recent flooding.

Mark Pfeiffer also mentioned that Hwy 49 will not be fixed anytime soon. He said it's looking like it will be closer to January 2027.

Darin Laymen mentioned that the Sheriff's office was awarded a grant for a Deputy Sheriff's salary supplemental fund. It's an additional \$3,000.00 for a certified peace officer's salary increase that does not come from taxpayer dollars, but instead from serving of civil processing papers.

9:14 a.m.: Scheduled appointments:

Jackie Rogers brought in the front porch plans for the Courthouse for the Commissioners to look over and review. They talked about different options for repairing the existing concrete and possibly redoing the stairs. They also discussed options for trim, railings, shutters etc.

9:35 a.m.: Old Business: Delta Regional Authority Grant Application Revision.

Mark Pfeiffer read aloud the Delta Regional Authority Resolution, addressing several motions that need to be made. The motions were as follows:

Whereas, a motion was made by Jared Boast, was seconded by Mark Pfeiffer, to designate and appoint Presiding Commissioner Steve Black to perform all duties and administration of said award, which carried unanimously by voice vote and was recorded on the minutes;

Whereas, a motion was made by Mark Pfeiffer, was seconded by Steve Black, to provide additional funds in the amount of \$300,000.00 to said award which carried unanimously by voice vote as was recorded on the minutes;

Whereas, a motion was made by Jared Boast, was seconded by Steve Black, to make an-kind contribution of removing roadside vegetation, trimming trees, inspecting/cleaning/replacing culverts with a fair market value of \$60,000.00 to said award which carried unanimously by voice vote and was recorded on the minutes; and

Whereas, a motion was made by Mark Pfeiffer, was seconded by Jared Boast, that in the event of an administration change, the new Presiding Commissioner shall continue to have such authority under this resolution.
